- SACSCOC requires QEP for reaffirmation
 - 5-year planning cycle and 5-year implementation process then the QEP is institutionalized-ie. Engage/CEBL
- QEP is bottom-up selection process where faculty/staff selects topic
- QEP is essentially a long project that impacts student success that will link to
 - Strategic plan
 - SMART
 - APRs
- Think very broad when thinking about student success-not necessarily academic
- Budget and resources are set up at the beginning of the project to set it up for success
- There is an assessment piece which is the 2nd most critical piece of the QEP
- Went over the meeting schedule (on website)
- Working timeline (on website)
 - Townhalls, meetings, etc.
 - Whittle-down process
 - Present to Senate and Cabinet to rubber stamp
 - Full year of writing
 - Reaffirmation year
 - On board the new QEP Director
 - Position is currently vacant and frozen due to covid.
 - Dana Gorzelany-Mostak and Jan Hoffmann have agreed to co-chair and shepherd the process
 - Collect data
 - On site visit
 - Implementation

- Included a list of common/trending topics on the website
- Included a link to the rubric SACS will use
- There is a change to the proposal process this time around.
 - Will use a submission template to submit proposals
 - Our office will help write proposals and provide any support you might need
 - Proposals are meant to be brief
 - Reach out to offices who can partner and support if a topic you are interested in isn't in your area of expertise
- Questions
 - Who votes for QEP?
 - Everyone will have opportunity to vote-faculty/staff/students/external stakeholders but primarily faculty and staff end up actually voting

- Who selects QEP Director?
 - Hiring committee will go through HR's hiring process and then the final decision goes to the Provost and President
 - Expect the committee's decision to be fully supported
- What is the voting method?
 - Not yet determined
 - Rachel Epstein offered to assist with setting up voting process
