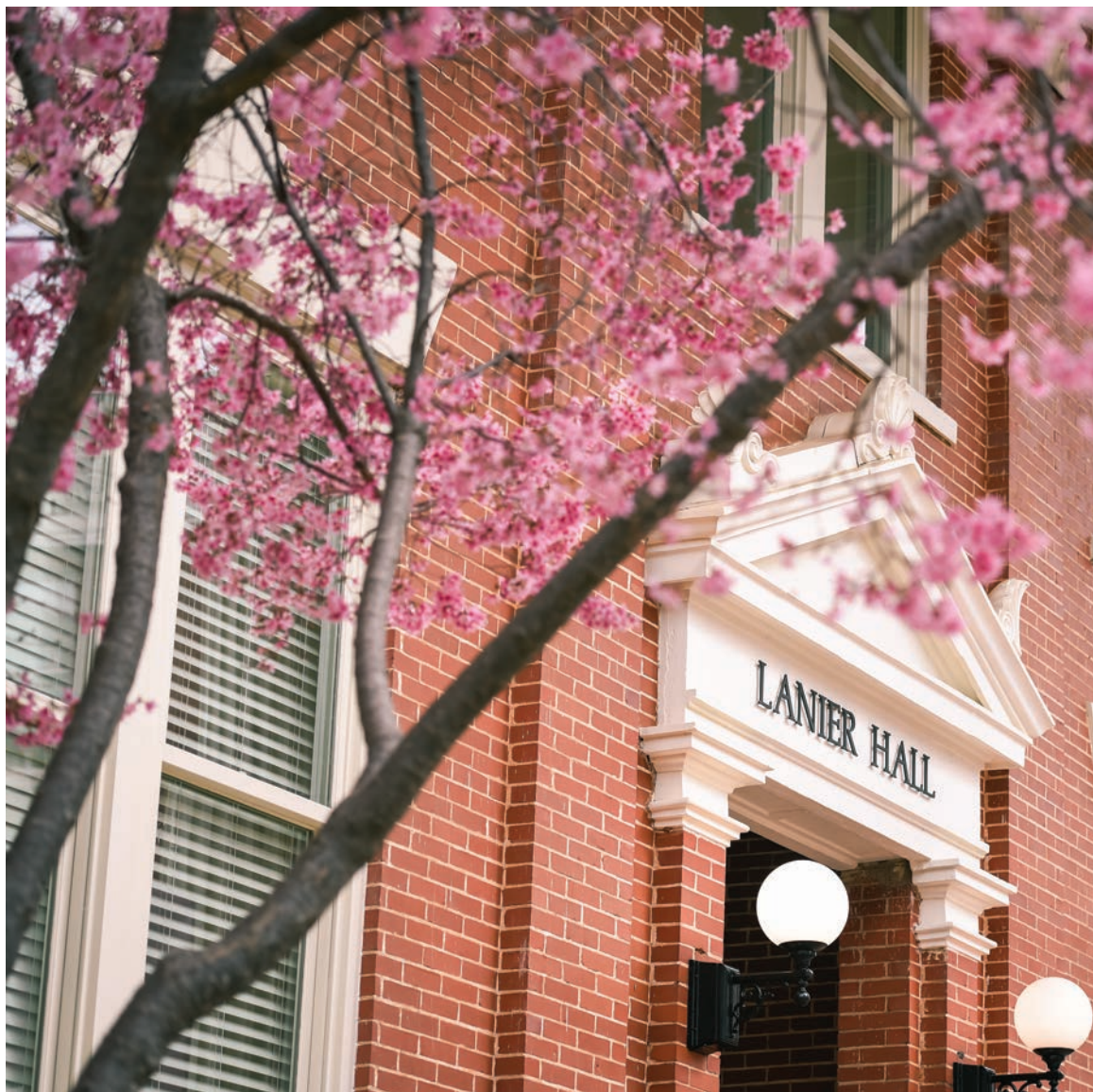

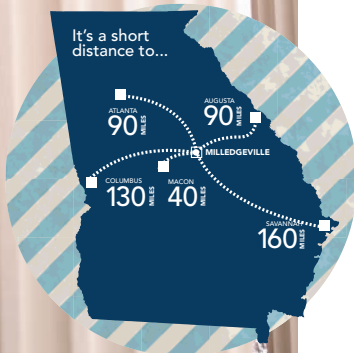
## About Georgia College

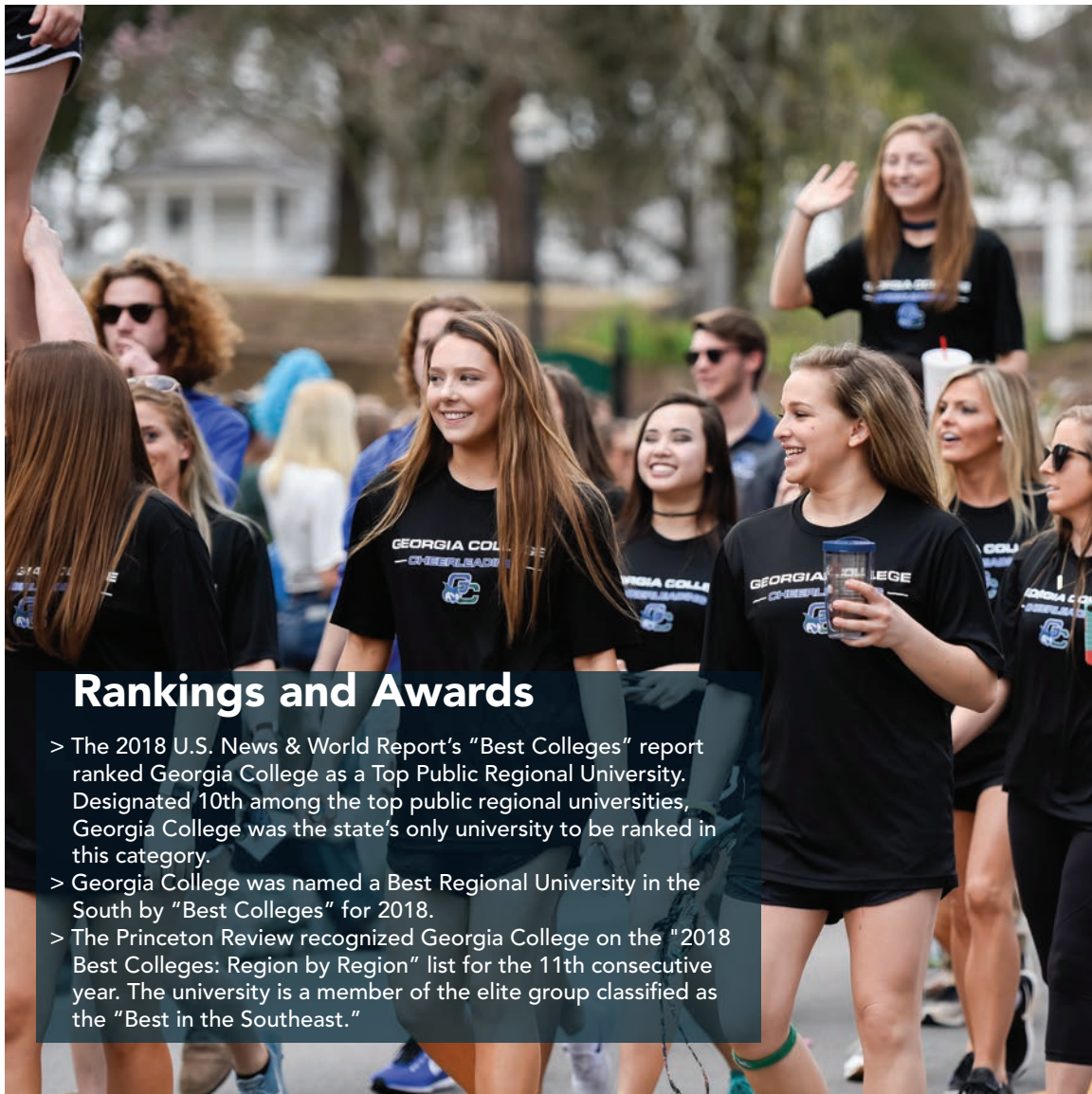

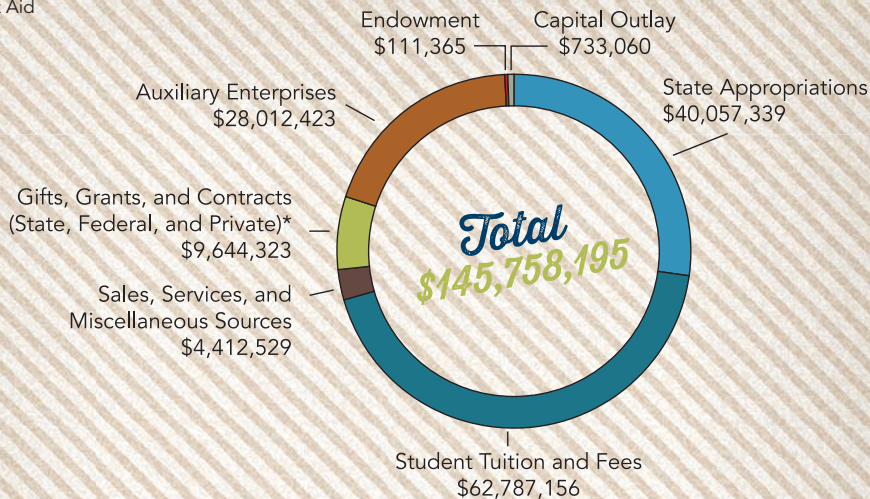
## Rankings and Awards
